- 1. DWR for Agreement #4600012700 2017 Proposition 1 Sustainable Groundwater Planning Grant: Discussion on retaining the grant and obtaining any future grants with a non-interest bearing clause. The language of the grant requires funds to be placed in a non-interest bearing account. The county auditor and treasurer state they are not willing to create a non-interest bearing account because of added administrative cost. However the auditor's office is willing to work with us so that the deposited funds do not earn interest. Language of Paragraph 6 of Agreement #4600012700
 - 6) <u>DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS.</u> The State will disburse to the Grantee the amount approved, subject to the availability of funds through normal State processes. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Grant Agreement, no disbursement shall be required at any time or in any manner which is in violation of, or in conflict with, federal or state laws, rules, or regulations, or which may require any rebates to the federal government, or any loss of tax-free status on state bonds, pursuant to any federal statute or regulation. Any and all money disbursed to the Grantee under this Grant Agreement shall be deposited in a non-interest bearing account and shall be used solely to pay Eligible Project Costs.

The Grantee may be excused from operations and maintenance only upon the written approval of the Deputy Director of the Division. For purposes of this Agreement, "operation costs" include direct costs incurred for material and labor needed for operations, utilities, insurance, and similar expenses. "Maintenance costs" include ordinary repairs and replacements of a recurring nature necessary to prolong the life of capital assets and basic structures, and the expenditure of funds necessary to replace or reconstruct capital assets or basic structures.
