**Invitation to Bid**  
**Shasta Valley RCD - Parks Creek Fish Passage Project**

**RECEIPT OF BIDS:** Sealed bids for construction of the Parks Creek Fish Passage Project will be received by the **Shasta Valley Resource Conservation District, 215 Executive Ct., Suite A, Yreka, CA 96097**, until **September 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019** at or before 2pm.

**OBTAINING BID DOCUMENTS:** BID DOCUMENTS may be obtained on or after August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Hardcopies will be available for \$20.00 by calling SVRCD at 530-572-3120. If you plan to obtain bid documents at the **mandatory pre-bid tour on September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019**, or would like them emailed to you, please email the Project Manager ([mriney@svrcd.org](mailto:mriney@svrcd.org)). BID DOCUMENTS will be available at the Shasta Builder's Exchange website.

**DESCRIPTION OF WORK:** The US Fish and Wildlife Service, National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, Bureau of Reclamation and CalTrans have awarded funds to the Shasta Valley RCD for a project to re-establish fish passage for all life stages of salmonids on Parks Creek under the Interstate 5 Bridge. This project includes the construction of an engineered roughened channel with sediment retention sills consisting of engineered and existing native streambed material and boulder buttresses. During implementation the creek will be diverted around the construction site via a temporary diversion pipe.

**CONTRACTOR EXPERIENCE:** This project requires that the contractor has experience in constructing roughened channel stream beds of the size and scope in the bid documents, and can provide references.

**CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE:** All construction activities are expected to be completed within *six weeks*, between Oct. 1, 2019 and Nov. 15, 2019.

**CONTRACTOR OBLIGATIONS, LICENSING AND REGISTRATIONS:** Contractor shall have an A CA Contractor's License. This project is a public works project. Contractor agrees to be bound by all the provisions of the California State Labor code regarding prevailing wages. The Contractor is expected to submit certified payroll on an established schedule to the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and be registered with (DIR).

**BONDING:** The Successful BIDDER will be required to furnish Performance and Payment Bonds, each in the amount not less than 100% of the contract price. All bidders must submit a Bid Security equal to 5% of the bid price.

**Bids are due no later than** September 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 2pm.
