



INVITATION TO BID

Parks Creek Riparian Improvement Project - Stockwater

ADDRESS, MARKING, AND RECEIPT OF BIDS: The envelope enclosing the bid shall be sealed and addressed to the Shasta Valley RCD and delivered or mailed to **215 Executive Ct., Suite A, Yreka, CA 96097**, no later than **2:00pm on August 23, 2021**. The envelope shall be plainly marked in the upper left-hand corner with the name and address of bidder and shall bear the words **‘Bid for Parks Creek Riparian Improvement Project – Stockwater’** and the date.

OBTAINING BID DOCUMENTS: BID DOCUMENTS may be obtained on or after **July 28, 2021**. Hardcopies will be available by calling SVRCD at 530-572-3120. If you plan to obtain bid documents and would like them emailed to you, please email the Project Manager (ebrown@svrcd.org). BID DOCUMENTS will also be available at the Shasta Builder’s Exchange website.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The State Water Resources Control Board has awarded funds to the Shasta Valley RCD for a project to improve riparian conditions and livestock management on private cattle ranching lands along Parks Creek by plumbing and constructing six alternative stockwatering systems between Old Highway 99 and Interstate 5.

CONTRACTOR EXPERIENCE: This project requires the contractor to have experience in constructing alternative livestock watering systems and public works contracts.

CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE: All construction activities are expected to be completed by January 1, 2022.

CONTRACTOR OBLIGATIONS, LICENSING AND REGISTRATIONS: Contractor shall have a C California Contractor’s License. This project is a public works project. Contractor agrees to be bound by all the provisions of the California State Labor code regarding prevailing wages. The Contractor is expected to submit certified payroll on an established schedule to the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and be registered with (DIR).

PRE-BID SITE TOUR: Contractors wishing to bid on this project are required to attend the **mandatory pre-bid tour** at **10:00am August 13, 2021**. Bidders will meet Shasta Valley RCD staff at the large Red Haybarn located on Old Highway 99 one quarter (0.25) mile north of the Hwy 99 Bridge crossing Parks Creek, near Edgewood. Bidders must come prepared to drive and walk through wet and muddy pastures, tall grass, and uneven terrain.

BONDING: The successful Bidder will be required to furnish Performance and Payment Bonds, each in the amount not less than 100% of the contract price. All bidders must submit a Bid Security equal to 5% of the bid price.
